

**TOWN OF RED CLIFF, COLORADO
ORDINANCE 2, SERIES 2015**

AN ORDINANCE REVISING SECTION 60 OF ARTICLE 2 OF CHAPTER 8 OF THE TOWN RED CLIFF MUNICIPAL CODE TO ESTABLISH NEW PARKING REGULATIONS TO ACCOMMODATE SNOW REMOVAL AND ROAD MAINTENANCE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Red Cliff (“Town”) is a municipal corporation and body politic organized under the laws of the State of Colorado and possessing the maximum powers, authority and privileges to which it is entitled under Colorado law;

WHEREAS, the Town, by virtue of its status, may adopt ordinances relative to local municipal matters as are necessary to effectuate the purposes and intents of the powers granted to municipalities, including, but not limited to, ordinances pertaining to parking in the Town;

WHEREAS, § 8-2-60 of the Town of Red Cliff Municipal Code (“Code”) presently prohibits parking on certain sides of certain Town streets on certain days from Labor Day through Memorial Day to accommodate snow removal;

WHEREAS, the Town’s Board of Trustees (“Board”) has determined that the parking restrictions embodied in the present version of § 8-2-60 of the Code are generally ineffective and unenforceable;

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the Town can more effectively, efficiently and flexibly accommodate snow removal from Town streets through periodic, temporary restrictions on parking.

WHEREAS, the Code does not presently include any provisions restricting or prohibiting parking to accommodate road maintenance; and,

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is necessary and proper for the Code to include provisions authorizing periodic, temporary restrictions on parking to accommodate road maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN OF RED CLIFF ORDAINS:

Section 1: Amendment. Section 60 of Article 2 of Chapter 8 of the Town of Red Cliff Municipal Code is amended to provide in its entirety:

Sec. 8-2-60 Snow Removal and Road Maintenance.

The Town will periodically post signs temporarily prohibiting parking in designated locations for the purposes of allowing the Town to remove snow from Town streets or perform road maintenance. It shall be a violation of this Article for any person to stop, stand or park a vehicle in any manner in contravention of any posted sign temporarily prohibiting parking in designated locations for the purposes of allowing the Town to remove snow from Town streets or perform road maintenance.


Section 2: Declaration. The Board of Trustees hereby finds, determines and declares that this Ordinance is necessary and proper to protect the public health, safety and welfare of the Town of Red Cliff and its inhabitants.

Section 3: Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause, provision or part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect, it being the intent of the Board of Trustees that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such invalid or unenforceable matter had not been included therein. It is further declared that if any section, provision or part of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance and the application thereof to other persons shall not be affected thereby.

Section 4: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication following final passage.


